

विराम चिह्न चक्र



The objective of this activity was to help students learn about different cereals grown in the Northern Plains and present the information creatively. The students collected various types of cereals, such as wheat, rice, barley, and maize, which are commonly grown in this region of India. Each type of cereal was placed in a separate zip pouch to keep them clean and organized. After collecting the cereals, students pasted some zip pouches containing different cereals in an A4 size sheets, arranging them neatly to leave sufficient space for writing. By the end of the activity, students gained a better understanding of the cereals grown in the Northern Plains and had the opportunity to develop their creativity and presentation skills.


REPORT ANYALYSIS ON ANNE FRANK'S LIFE INTO HIDING

MATHEMATICS

EQUIVALENT FRACTIONS

The Equivalent Fractions activity was an effective introduction to the concept of equivalent fractions for the fifth-grade students. The goal of this activity was to reinforce their understanding of equivalent fractions through an engaging and interactive approach. During the activity, students used paper strips to explore fractions visually. They divided the strips into various segments and shaded them to represent different fractions. For instance, they learned that 1/2, 2/4, and 4/8 are equivalent fractions because they represent the same proportion of a whole. By dividing a strip into 2 equal parts and shading one, the result is visually consistent with dividing the strip into 4 parts and shading two, or dividing it into 8 parts and shading four. Through this hands-on experience, students were able to grasp the concept of equivalent fractions more effectively, enhancing their ability to identify and work with fractions in a meaningful way.



EVS-I

PARTS OF BRAIN

In our recent Experiential Learning activity, we explored the intricate structure of the human brain. The objective was to understand the different parts of the brain, including the cerebrum, cerebellum, and medulla, and their functions. Through this hands-on activity, students created a 2D model of the human brain on an A4-sized sheet using clay, which helped them visualize and comprehend the brain's complex anatomy. Students used different colors of clay to create and label a 2D model of the brain, representing parts like the cerebrum, cerebellum, and medulla. This hands-on activity enhanced their understanding of the brain's structure and functions while developing their observation and data-recording skills, effectively combining theoretical knowledge with practical application.





EVS-II

COLLAGE MAKING ON DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

The experiential learning activity undertaken by Grade 5 students, focusing on creating collages about the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). The activity aimed to provide students with an engaging, hands-on experience to explore and understand various aspects of the DRC through art and creativity. The collages produced by the students depicted various elements, including the country's flag, natural vegetation, climate, life of the people, landform, rivers, food, and crops etc. Using the collected images and materials, students created collages that represented their findings. Each collage included a combination of pictures and artistic elements to depict various aspects of the DRC. By researching and visually representing various aspects of the country, students gained valuable insights into its geography, culture, and daily life.
