JULY ACTIVITY REPORT

<u>**Cup Slider Activity-**</u> A Word Building Activity was conducted in the UKG class. It was an effective method for enhancing the spelling and vocabulary of the students. To do this activity, the teacher gave the students cups with letters written on them, and the students created new words by sliding the cups. Through this activity, children learned various words and improved several skills interactively.



Lemonade Party - The UKG teachers organized a refreshing and fun-filled lemonade party for their students as a special treat on a warm day. The children had a great time preparing the lemonade by squeezing lemons, sprinkling sugar and salt, and stirring the mixture with their tiny hands. This activity gave them hands-on experience in making a glass of lemonade. While preparing the drink, they developed their measurement skills by carefully measuring the ingredients. At the same time, they enhanced their social skills through sharing, taking turns, collaborating as a team, and demonstrating good manners.



Seed Germination Activity UKG students enjoyed seed germination activity as a part of their experiential learning. They filled tiny pots with soil and sowed few seeds of chickpeas in it. The main objective of the activity was to make them aware that different elements like sunlight, air & water are necessary for the growth of plants. It was an enriching experience for the students.



Shapes Activity - The Shapes Activity was conducted for UKG students, where they matched the shape outlines with the actual shapes pasted on another glass. Through this activity, students were able to identify the number of sides that triangles, rectangles, squares, and circles have. This activity also helped them in improving their hand-eye coordination.



Word Building Activity – Word building activity is a great tool to help children learn to break words down into smaller components. LKG students assembled the blocks and made simple words like cat, sun, and pan. This hands-on approach not only reinforced vocabulary but also helped in enhancing fine motor skills and spatial awareness.



Shapes Rocket Activity- To develop and deepen the knowledge of different shapes in a fun-filled and easy way, the Shapes Rocket Activity was organized for the students of Class LKG. Students used cut-outs of different shapes to create their rockets. This hands-on activity made learning engaging and motivating for our young learners and was indeed an enriching experience for them.



Paper Boat Making Activity- The Paper Boat Making Activity was conducted in the LKG classes. Each child was provided with colourful sheets of paper and step-by-step guidance. As they folded, they explored concepts such as shapes and symmetry. This activity was a great success, with all students enthusiastically participating and successfully creating their paper boats.



Let's Go Fishing Activity- In this activity, the teachers created small props of colourful fish, and the students of Class Nursery picked up pictures that began with the 'F' sound and placed them in a tub using a magnetic fishing rod. While engaging in this activity, the children focused on a specific letter, which helped them recognize the letter and its vocabulary words.

Number Matching Game- In this activity, children counted the dots on different coloured popsicle sticks and matched them to the corresponding number of sticks. This engaging exercise not only enhanced their fine motor skills but also supported their number recognition.



Balloon Dabbing Activity- In this activity, kids dipped balloons in red paint and made impressions on the pictures. It was a fun experience that helped them recognize the red colour and also enhanced their fine motor skills. The children thoroughly enjoyed this creative activity!



<u>**Tearing and Pasting Activity**</u>- Tearing and pasting is an innovative activity that helps in the development of motor skills.
