## **GLIMPSES OF ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE MONTH OF OCTOBER**

**SPONGE PRINTING ACTIVITY** - The UKG students participated in an exciting Sponge Printing Activity, where they discovered a vibrant world of colours and textures while crafting their artistic masterpieces. This engaging experience not only improved their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination but also provided them with a sensory-rich environment through sponge dabbing. As they explored different colours and textures, their creativity flourished, making the activity both enjoyable and educational.



**OCTOPUS MAKING ACTIVITY**- In this activity, UKG students rolled paper to form the body of an octopus, and with the teacher's guidance, they carefully crafted the legs. This hands-on experience sparked their creativity and enthusiasm while enhancing their fine motor skills. The students were thrilled to bring their octopus creations to life!



**FUN SCIENCE ACTIVITY** - A Fun Science Activity was conducted for UKG students to enhance their learning experience. The children created the outline of a fish using a washing powder solution, and after it dried, they applied turmeric powder, which caused a fascinating colour change. The students were amazed to see the transformation from yellow to reddish. This hands-on experience not only delighted the children but also served as an excellent opportunity to foster critical thinking and observation skills.



**THREAD PAINTING ACTIVITY** - In this activity, children dipped pieces of thread in different paint colours and arranged them on one half of a folded paper. After covering it with the other half and pulling the thread quickly, they revealed unique designs when the paper was unfolded. The children enjoyed this creative exploration, which fostered their imagination and artistic skills while developing fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.



<u>CLAY MODELLING ACTIVITY</u>- Clay modelling is a fun activity that provides many benefits for young children. It helps improve hand-eye coordination and builds both gross and fine motor skills. The LKG children were excited to create different types of transportation using clay, which allowed them to use their imagination. **WORD TRAY ACTIVITY**- The Word Tray Activity helped enhance reading and phonics skills among LKG students. In this activity, students created different words using letters and their sounds. This hands-on experience boosted their confidence in reading and increased their familiarity with phonetic sounds.



**TRANSPORT ACTIVITY-** In the Transport Activity, LKG children pasted pictures of vehicles according to their modes of transport—air, water, and land. **LETTER 'Z' SORTING ACTIVITY**- In this activity, students looked for pictures that started with the 'Z' sound and placed them in a zip frame. This sorting activity helped build memory skills and was a fun way for Nursery children to learn about the vocabulary words related to the letter 'Z'.



**BOAT MAKING ACTIVITY-** Nursery students created colourful boats using origami paper. This engaging activity strengthened their brains and improved their hand-eye coordination and fine motor skills. As they folded the paper, they followed simple instructions, which helped them focus and develop their abilities. The children had a wonderful time making their boats.



**WIDE & NARROW ACTIVITY** - This activity helped children compare objects based on their width. In this engaging session, Nursery children examined various pictures of objects to distinguish between wide and narrow items. They then sorted these pictures based on their width. It was a fun and interactive way for them to learn about sizes and enhance their observational skills.



**LION FACE MAKING ACTIVITY-** Pre-Nursery students had a fantastic time creating lion faces using forks. Through this creative activity, they learned about the lion's appearance and the sound of its mighty roar. The children thoroughly enjoyed this hands-on activity, which helped them develop their creativity and understanding of animals.



**STORY SESSION**- Pre-Nursery children had a delightful time during their story session.
