Straw Beading Activity- Nursery students took active part in this activity and it turned out to be the favorite activity amongst children. They started threading; straw by straw, bead by bead, and made sure that each straw & bead reached the end of the string. This activity helped in developing fine motor skills, visual perception, visual-motor and cognitive skills.


