The physical aspect of our student's growth is ensured through various sports activities like yoga, skating, cricket, football, basketball in which our students have achieved many honours. A wholesome blend of cultural and academic activities, provides great opportunities to our students to explore diverse arenas and imbibe different values. During the Annual day, mass participation is encouraged which gives the student an opportunity to develop confidence and skill by performing on stage, imparting life skill and making education a living experimental activity.

### **Guidelines for Parents**

- 1. Parents are requested to read the contents of the School Almanac carefully and in the interest of the child, abide by the rules and regulations laid down by the school.
- 2. Parents are requested to drop their ward five minutes before the school bell rings, as the school gates will be closed thereafter.
- 3. Kindly ensure that your ward's homework is complete and he/she carries course books, exercise books according to the time table for that day.
- 4. If your ward is absent from the school, ensure that he / she makes up for all the class work missed by him/her. The required detail may be collected from fellow students.

- 5. Apart from the Class room teaching, students are expected to devote 2-3 hours regularly at home for self-study.
- 6. Every student is expected to maintain an attendance record of at least 75% during the academic year, failing to which, he/she may not be allowed to appear in the final examination in March.
- 7. Mobile Phone is strictly prohibited in the school premises.
- 8. Preparation and issuance of documents like: Transfer certificate, Character certificate, Fee certificate, Date of Birth certificate etc. takes time, so parents are requested to apply for the same atleast 15 days before they require it.
- 9. Parents are requested to sign the reports, test papers, teacher's remarks in the note book and school Almanac and other similar documents so that they may keep in close touch with the progress of their child. Parents are also expected to visit the teachers whenever called, requested or on PTM.
- 10. Please do not send your child to school if he/she is feeling unwell. A proper leave application must be submitted in writing by the parents to the Principal in case of absence. This should be supported by a medical certificate in case of sick leave for more than three consecutive days.
- 11. Please abstain from taking leave for your ward for a half day for security reasons. In case of emergency, please take written permission from the Principal and the Class teacher. Bus in-charge must be duly informed. Parent ID card is mandatory.
- 12. Students will not be allowed to leave early or take a half day after the unit test or any other examination.

### **Rules & Regulations**

### Admissions

- 1. The Management reserves with itself the right of admissions.
- 2. (a) Before a student can be considered for admission, the Registration Form duly filled in and signed by either of the parents must be deposited in the school along with the pre-admission process fee. If neither of the parents is alive or present, the lawful guardian of the child can sign the form.
  - (b) A child who has not attained the age of 6 years as on cutoff date will not be admitted to class I. Admission to higher or lower classes will be governed by this rule.
- 3. (a) A child who has previously studied in another recognised school will have to submit a Transfer Certificate from the school last attended.
  - (b) Transfer Certificate from a school must be countersigned by the Education Officer of the District concerned.
  - (c) Municipal Birth Certificate will have to be submitted for admission of a child who has not attended any recognised school previously.
  - (d) Care must be taken to enter the name and the date of birth of the child correctly with accuracy. Subsequent changes in the date of birth or name will not be permitted.
  - (e) As per the CBSE norms, Aadhar Card of your ward must be submitted at the school admin office for updating the school records.
  - (f) Record of immunisation must be submitted.
  - (g) Admission is finalised after a preliminary / interaction test and / or interview and payment of the prescribed fees, which once paid is not refundable.
  - (h) Before admission, the parents should satisfy themselves that adequate transport arrangements exist for their wards from the place of residence to the school and back. Deviation from the established route or a change in the time schedule will not be permitted. Parents who shift their residence have to officially inform the school about the same so that proper changes are made in the school records. It is mandatory that this procedure should be carried out by parents themselves and not through correspondence or through their child.
  - (i) Classes for students who have appeared for class X Board Examinations will commence before the results are declared. For class XI stream allotments, it is entirely at the discretion of the Management. Final allotment of streams are done only after the Board Results. Parents desiring their ward to continue in the school are required to apply in a prescribed form. Parents who do not submit the admission proforma to the school within the prescribed time, will forfeit their chance to be admitted in the School.

### **EXAMINATION AND ASSESSMENT RULES**

### Class I and II

### Holistic Progress Card (HPC)

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 restructured school education into a 5+3+3+4 framework to better align with the developmental needs of students. The 360-degree Holistic Progress Card (HPC) has replaced the traditional report cards. The HPC serves as a comprehensive, multidimensional tool for assessing each child's unique growth. It integrates feedback from various stakeholders, including parents, peers, and teachers, fostering a sense of self-awareness and building confidence in learners. Key features of the Holistic Progress Card:

- Positive Learning Habits Physical Development
- Socio-emotional and Ethical Development
- Cognitive Development
- Language and Literacy Development
- Aesthetic and Cultural Development

Holistic reporting empowers educators and parents to gain a deeper understanding of a student's strengths, areas for improvement, and overall growth. Through the Holistic Progress Card and the principles of interdisciplinary learning, NEP 2020 ensures that students are equipped not only for academic success but for lifelong well-being and citizenship.

- Assessments will be conducted in four parts as part of a Unit Test/ Comprehensive Evaluation.
- Weekly assessments will be held on a weekly basis, covering all subjects.
- Subject-specific enrichment activities will be performance oriented and the students would be assessed for reading, listening and speaking skills, mental math, project work.
- An ailing child must not be brought to school to give a test. Parents may write an application to seek permission of the Principal for their ward to appear in the retest.
- Retests will not be conducted in case of absenteeism. (In case there is no information about the child's absence.)
- Early dispersal is not allowed on the days of assessment. For the student to be
  marked for her/his assessment, it is mandatory to attend all the classes for the
  day. Provision of retest is available strictly for medical cases. An application
  must be sent/mailed to the class teacher/school a day prior/ on the day of
  assessment before 8:00am in case the child is unwell. Medical certificate must

- be shared within 2 days of the submission of the application in the absence of which the child will be marked as absent for that assessment.
- A minimum of 75% attendance is required to be eligible to qualify for promotion to the next class.

### Class III

- The school follows system of continuous and comprehensive evaluation (CCE) through Weekly Unit Test and Subject specific enrichment activities.
- The session is divided into two terms April to September and October to March and each term carry 50 marks.
- There would be four cycles of Unit Test in the session
- The weekly unit test will be held on Monday in rotation for all subjects.
- Subject-specific enrichment activities will be performance oriented and the students would be assessed for reading, listening and speaking skills, mental math, project work.
- An ailing child must not be brought to school to give a test. Parents may write an application to seek permission of the Principal for their ward to appear in the retest.
- Retests will not be conducted in case of absenteeism. (In case there is no information about the child's absence.)
- Early dispersal is not allowed on the days of assessment. For the student to be
  marked for her/his assessment, it is mandatory to attend all the classes for the
  day. Provision of retest is available strictly for medical cases. An application
  must be sent/mailed to the class teacher/school a day prior/ on the day of
  assessment before 8:00am in case the child is unwell. Medical certificate must
  be shared within 2 days of the submission of the application in the absence of
  which the child will be marked as absent for that assessment.
- A minimum of 75% attendance is required to be eligible to qualify for promotion to the next class.

### Class IV to VIII

### \* (<u>Please refer to the Promotion Criteria for students of Grades V and VIII (For promotion to Grade VI and Grade IX)</u>

- The school follows a system of "Uniform Assessments laid down by CBSE on the basis of performance and learning through periodic test, exams(i.e.) half yearly and annual and subject enrichment activities.
- The session is divided into two terms:

**Term I**-April to September: One periodic Test and Half-Yearly Examination. **Term II**- October to March: One periodic Test and Annual Examination.

- It is compulsory for every student to appear in all the subject's examination
- The weekly periodic test would be held twice a year on Monday's for all subjects.
- Subject-specific enrichment activities will be performance oriented and the students would be assessed for reading, listening and speaking skills, Math and Science lab, project work.
- An ailing child must not be brought to school to give a test. Parents may write an application to seek permission of the Principal for their ward to appear in the retest.
- Retests will not be conducted in case of absenteeism. (In case there is no information about the child's absence.)
- Early dispersal is not allowed on the days of assessment. For the student to be marked for her/his assessment, it is mandatory to attend all the classes for the day. Provision of retest is available strictly for medical cases. An application must be sent/mailed to the class teacher/school a day prior/ on the day of assessment before 8:00am in case the child is unwell. Medical certificate must be shared within 2 days of the submission of the application in the absence of which the child will be marked as absent for that assessment.
- A minimum of 75% attendance is required to be eligible to qualify for promotion to the next class.

### \* <u>Promotion Criteria for students of Grades V and VIII (For promotion to Grade VI and Grade IX)</u>

- Attendance: **A minimum of 75%** attendance is required to be eligible to appear for the annual examination.
- Passing Criteria: Students must secure a minimum of 33% in the theory examination (main paper) to be eligible for promotion.
  - Provision for students unable to meet the passing criteria:
- Compartment Examination (After Annual Examination): Students failing in one
  out of seven subjects may appear for a compartment examination for that
  subject, provided they have passed the Third Language examination.
- Only one attempt is allowed for the compartment examination. If a student fails
  the compartment examination, s/he will not be promoted to the next class
  (Grade VI / Grade IX).

### Classes X - XII

 Class X - XII Student will be assessed both in scholastic and co-scholastic area as per the CBSE guidelines for session 2025-26

- General Rules:-
- Student has to secure 33% marks in each subject and overall 40% to get promoted to next class.
- 75% attendance is a must, to appear in final exams.
- No retest will be conducted. In case of serious illness, medical certificate needs to be submitted.
- Students found using unfair means, during exams will be marked zero in that subject and serious action will be taken against them.

### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

(For Payment of School dues)

- 1. Fee is payable in advance by 15th of the first month for the quarters i.e. APRIL, JULY, OCT & JAN.
  - 2. Monthly fee to be paid by 10th of every month.
  - 3. Fee can be paid by payee's A/c Cheque favouring Ralli International School. Parents should write name in Block Letters, Admission No., Class & Section of the child & Mobile No. of the parents on the reverse side of the cheque & re-check the same before depositing or dropping it in the Drop Box.
  - 4. Fee can be paid online at www.rallinternationalschool.com
  - 5. If the payment is made by cheque, separate cheques should be made for each sibling.
  - 6. Transport fee is charged for 11 months, payable quarterly. This facility can't be availed for one or two months. No one is allowed to withdraw bus facility w.e.f. Oct to Mar, except in the case of change of address or withdrawal from school. To withdraw the bus facility one month advance notice has to be given to the Principal. If you want to withdraw the bus facility in the middle of the quarter, the entire fee of that quarter will be charged.
  - 7. In case fee cheque is dis-honoured, fine of Rs 500/- will be charged.
  - 8. If fee is not paid by due date, a fine of Rs 10/- per day will be charged upto the end of the quarter, after which the student's name will be struck off from the school rolls. Re-admission will be granted only if there is vacancy in the class and re-admission fee of Rs 25,000/- will be charged.

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- 9. If a student attends school even for a single day, he/she is liable to pay the fee for the full quarter.
- 10. Fee once paid, will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 11. Parents are advised to keep the fee receipt in their safe custody and produce it for reconciliation, if and when required.
- 12. No deletion/alteration of any amount is permissible.
- 13. The last clearance payment of school dues at the time of withdrawal is to be accepted by cash only.
- 14. Deposit of school fee is the responsibility of the parents, failing to which the school is authorised to take suitable action, as per the rules.
- 15 The school office will remain open during the Summer, Autumn & Winter Breaks, on all working days.
- 16. The school will not be responsible for delay in the payment of fee and no reminder will be issued in this regard.
- 17. Full year payment can be made in advance.
- 18. The school fee counter will remain open from 8:00 am to 2:30 pm on all working days.

### **RULES OF WITHDRAWAL**

- If the student wants to withdraw his/her name from the next academic session, he /she should apply before 28th February and pay fee upto 31st March.
- One month's advance notice is to be submitted or fee in lieu of, is to be paid when student is to be withdrawn. The School leaving Certificate will not be issued till all school dues have been settled.
- 3. A student who has once taken his/her transfer certificate and seek readmission in the school, it would be treated as New Admission.
- 4. In case of cancellation of admission, whatsoever be the reason, nothing will be refunded except security deposit.

The school gate will close at 8.45 a.m. sharp for Nursery and Pre-Primary students and 9.00 a.m. for Pre-Nursery Students. After that no student will be allowed to enter the School.

### **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:**

- 1. The academic curriculum is strongly supported by an extensive range of co-curricular activities.
- 2. A host of co-curricular activities are conducted to ensure holistic development of children.
- 3. There are opportunities to learn music (vocal and instrumental), art and dance and participate in school competitions and functions.
- 4. A plethora of Intra-section, Inter-class and Inter-house competitions and special assemblies ensure participation of each child of the school.
- 5. Students are provided with ample opportunities to participate in a wide range of activities.

### Attendance:

- For any kind of absence, a written application signed by the Parent / Guardian is required on the day the student returns. If a student is absent for more than 3 days on reason of ill health, a certificate from a doctor is required stating illness and fitness.
- 2. A student who arrives late will require to bring an explanatory note, in writing, from the parent/guardian.
- 3. The students who are regularly sick and fall short of the required 75% of attendance may be asked to leave the school on grounds of physical unfitness.
- 4. The students late for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time in a term will be sent home and considered absent.
- 5. The students will not be allowed to leave the school early unless Parents/Guardians send a written note along with the parent I.D. card to the office. In such cases permission from the Principal is necessary.
- 6. In case of infectious disease, the parents are required to submit a medical certificate to ensure that the child is fit to rejoin.
- 7. Any unscheduled holidays may be made by the school without prior intimation to parents/guardians.
- 8. Confirmation regarding any unscheduled holidays can be done by checking the school website or the notice board at the gate.

### DISCIPLINE

- 1. Lunch box, food items, water bottle, books, school bag, projects will not be accepted at the reception.
- 2. No gifts and sweets will be allowed in the school premises for any kind of celebration or birthday.
- 3. Parents are requested to drop their ward five minutes before the school bell rings, as the school gates will be closed thereafter.
- Parents are requested not to provide mobile phones to their children, as they are strictly prohibited in school premises. Any confiscated device will not to be returned.
- 5. Kindly ensure that your ward's homework is completed and he/she carries course books, exercise books according to the time table for that day.

### <u>General Discipline :</u>

- 1. It is vitally important that changes in residence / office addresses and telephone numbers be communicated in writing to the office immediately when they occur.
- 2. The School does not hold itself responsible for injuries sustained by student while in the school. However, first-aid will be rendered immediately and injuries necessitating Hospital / OPD treatment will be attended to, without delay.

- 3. The Students are advised not to take private tuition. Parents are urged to encourage their children to do their daily work diligently and honestly and to pay utmost attention to the studies in the class room.(If there be real need, contact the Principal for help.)
- 4. Parents are encouraged to have their children undergo medical examination regularly for general well being, specially dental, ear and eye care.
- 5. Parents or students (individually or collectively) are forbidden to give gifts to teachers. Neither parents, nor any students are allowed to gift presents on birthdays of students or any such occasions. A token gift of a flower or a sweet may be allowed as a special case.
- 6. The Collection of funds for whatever use is forbidden without the prior permission of the Principal. Students shall not sell or take order for any merchandise in school or in the name of the School.
- 7. Students are required to behave politely and avoid use of indecent language or actions injurious to the feelings of fellow students, teachers or others in the school. Any such behaviour indicative of hurting others, or hurting any caste or community will attract serious disciplinary action.
- 8. Serious violation of the rules, regulations and the discipline of the school is punishable including removal or expulsion from School. Such action will normally follow a written warning to allow improvement in conduct.
- 9. Immediate exclusion and / or even rustication will follow if the continued presence of the defaulting student is damaging to the physical and moral well-being of other students and of the School, or if the violation is punishable seriously at the Board level, such as unfair practice at the examination.
- 10. In the absence of the teacher from the classroom, students are required to observe silence and obey the monitor of the class. While traveling by School bus, they are expected to follow the instructions of the driver / conductor / bus monitors / teacher in charge of the bus.
- 11. Fines, which may be deemed necessary to be imposed on the students, are only to improve or to enforce discipline.
- 12. Students may be required to take part in various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities even outside School hours. When so required, participation will be deemed compulsory.
- Staying away from mandatory school functions, including Annual day and Sports
  Day without prior permission and/or justification will be considered a discipline
  default.
- 14. Parents are expected to give adequate time to their children to help them in their studies, provide them with a quiet place to study, insist on a homework time which

- is free from distraction, check with teachers when assignments or other instructions are not clear, encourage their children to do their best so far as accuracy and neatness is concerned, encourage them to read books at home and to collect material which will help them in their education.
- 15. English being the medium of instruction in the School, students must speak in English even in their private conversations during school hours. Using abusive and indecent language repeatedly may lead to expulsion from school.
- 16. The Safety of every student is a major concern of the School. Therefore the following should be strictly observed:-
  - (a) Students will wear the identity card with the school uniform.
  - (b) Parents of pre-primary students are required to teach their children their name, address and telephone numbers.
  - (c) If the child has to go to a place other than the normal one, a note from the parents must be sent to the School requesting permission and stating the reason for the child to go to a different address after school.
- 17. Students are accountable to school authorities for their conduct not only in the School but also for their general behaviour outside. Any report or observed objectionable conduct outside the School on the part of the students will make them liable to disciplinary action. It is expected that through their good behaviour they enhance the prestige of the School.
- 18. Parents are advised to inform the Principal about any problem they may be facing regarding their children, keeping in mind that it is only with the sincerity and openness of the parents that the School will be able to help their child become a good human being & overcome his / her weaknesses. Needless to say that the disclosures made will be treated with utmost confidentiality.
- 19. The students are not allowed to enter classroom other than their own.
- 20. A Student involved in any incident even outside the School which brings discredit to the institution either because of unpleasant nature or inviting criminal or legal action by police or the court will be dismissed from school without further enquiry.
- 21. Any student found traveling at odd hours with fellow students in a motorized vehicle without parent's permission and/or without a proper valid licence will be liable for disciplinary action, if this is brought to the notice of the School authorities.
- 22. Although the conservation of our environment is fundamental, it is also equally important that applications made to the Principal or the School Office be done on a decent sheet of paper. Applications submitted to the office or to the Principal inappropriately will not be considered.

### **School Diary**

- Every student must possess a copy of the School diary of the current session which should be brought to school everyday. Apart from entering legibly the name and other personal data, students should not enter in it any thing except what relates to school work.
- 2. School diary is to be preserved carefully and no page from it should be destroyed or smudged.
- 3. Notes given by the Principal or teachers should be duly signed by the parents.
- 4. Parents are expected to look into and sign their ward's School Diary everyday.
- 5. If a student loses the diary, he/she will be subject to disciplinary action and a new diary will have to be purchased.

### **Personal Belongings**

- Students should not bring valuables or money to school. They are also not allowed to bring magazines, pictures or books/cassettes CD and pen drive, other than the prescribed text books except when asked by the teacher, to the school
- 2. Students found in possession of material of any indecent matter are liable to rustication without notice.
- 3. Bursting crackers or carrying inflammable material in the school is considered by the school as an indicator of intention to harm others, cause disturbance and damage to life and property and a serious violation of the fundamental tenets of the school, namely respect and concern for ones fellow beings. Any body found or reported to have carried the activity in the school either personally or through others is liable to be suspended. It may even lead to dismissal after verification.
- 4. Every student should take care of his/her personal belongings. School authorities do not assume the responsibility for loss of such belongings.
- 5. Name of the student and class should be marked on the personal belongings to facilitate recovery when lost in the school premises.
- 6. Carrying of cell phones, ipods or other electronic devices is contrary to the school discipline. Students found carrying such devices or reported to have been carrying may be punished with confiscation, fine or both. In case of confiscated goods, the school will not be responsible for its loss in the custody of the school, as the same will be deposited in the regular staff room of the school.

### Cleanliness

- 1. Parents are expected to check the hair cut, nails, uniform on regular basis.
- 2. The students must come to school in neat and well ironed School uniforms. Those coming in crumpled or stained uniforms or unpolished shoes are liable to be sent back home or fined.
- 3. It is the duty of all the students to keep their classrooms and other places in and around the school clean and in order. They should cultivate the habit of using the dustbin.
- 4. No student is allowed to write on the black board unless asked to do so by the teachers.
- 5. Before leaving the classroom, students will pick up waste paper and any unwanted material from the floor and place it in the waste paper basket; will leave desks and chairs in proper arrangement; will put off lights and fans; will close windows; in general the room will be left in a condition to be used again.

### **School Property**

- 1. Every student should take care of the school property; intended or neglectful damage to school property is a serious breach of school discipline and will have to be made good by the defaulting students.
- 2. Damage caused even by accident, should be reported at once to the class teacher or the supervisor.

### Library

- Library books are issued to the students once a week, on the day fixed for each class. They must be returned at the end of the week and if required may be reissued.
- 2. Students must acquire the habit of reading as it is important for their educational process. Parents are required to urge their children to cultivate this habit.
- Students are expected to take care of the library books. Writing or marking on a book is strictly forbidden. Damages/Loss of books while in possession of the student will have to be made good by the student in whose name the book has been issued.
- 4. Books must be returned before the holidays.
- 5. Students who fail to return the books on the assigned day will be liable to pay a fine of Rs. 2.00 per day.
- 6. If the reader's ticket is lost, it can be obtained by paying of Rs. 20/-.
- 7. Students must maintain silence in the library.

### **Transportation**

- 1. This section is subject to change in view of the Supreme Court directive without any notice.
- 2. Students who avail the school transport should report to the assigned pick-up point at least five minutes before the stipulated time.

- 3. A Student will not be permitted to board a bus other than the one to which he/she is assigned.
- 4. Student will board the buses in an orderly manner, giving due priority to younger students.
- 5. Students availing private transport must report to school before the Morning Assembly begins. No cars or any other mode of transport will be permitted to be parked, during the school time in front of the school.
- 6. Any request to change the bus route/stop must be submitted in writing to the Principal prior to the change that is to be made. Bus monitors shall be assigned to help maintain discipline.
- 7. The following acts are considered serious violations:
  - (a) Discourtesy and disobedience to the driver or conductor.
  - (b) Changing places frequently while the bus is in motion.
  - (c) Discourtesy to other children.
  - (d) Pushing and jostling when boarding the bus.
  - (e) Trying to distract the bus driver's attention.
  - (f) Destroying bus property.

Note: Payment for damage will be required before the offender is reinstated in the bus.

- 8. In the event, of a child being involved in a disciplinary problem while travelling in a bus, the Principal, at her discretion, may take any disciplinary action, even suspending the offender from availing the bus facility.
- 9. Parents who want their children to avail the school transport facilities shall give a written undertaking that the school will not be held responsible for any damage/injury/loss of life and/or property due to any accident.
- 10. The bus service is liable to be withdrawn or changed from any area as and when it is not found to be feasible. Transport charges vary according to the distances. However, transport charges may be increased when the need arises, and this may be done without prior notice.
- 11. A calendar month's notice must be given in writing before withdrawing a student from the bus. However, students who have availed the School transport for the second and third quarters, will not be allowed to discontinue it for the last quarter.
- 12. Parents are responsible for ensuring the safe return of students required to stay in school after school hours when transport is not provided by the school.
- 13. The school is not responsible for any student who boards wrong bus from school by intent or goes to another student's house without explicit information from the parent.
- 14. All the students are required to note and parents are required to educate the students to board their proper bus and in case of doubt may stay back in school for remedial action.

15. The school transport facility will be made available only if seating capacity in a given transport exists. There is no automatic bus transport for a student.

### Meetings (PTM)

- Parents/Guardians are not allowed to meet the teachers during the class hours.
   Those wishing to visit the school or meet the staff of the school must first obtain permission from the Principal.
- 2. Periodic meetings of parents with the teachers will be arranged by the Principal in order to ensure co-ordination in the process of the child's performance. The notings made by the teacher in the PTM register should be signed by the parents.
- 3. Parents who regularly fail to attend Parent-Teacher Meeting will be deemed to be not interested in the students' education and as this is pernicious to the school in general and the student in particular, subsequently the student may be asked to discontinue.
- 4. On completion of all the examinations, report cards should be personally collected by the Parents/Guardians.
- 5. Beside the meetings arranged regularly, parents are expected to attend to instructions given through the diary or through special notes and come to school when so required.
- 6. Parents of academically weak and/or of students with unsteady disciplinary conduct, who fail to attend P.T.M. meetings will be deemed to be uninterested in their ward's education.

### School Clinic

The Medical record available in the school diary should be filled up by all parents.

The school clinic is looked after by the qualified staff. Medical check up of students is done regularly and a record is maintained. Parents are duly informed, if the doctor finds that a child needs special medical attention.

Parents are requested not to send sick-children to school for attending classes, appearing for examinations or tests.

### **House System**

There are four houses in the school. Every student from class I - XII is placed in one of these houses. Each house is headed by one boy and one girl known as House Captains. A member of the staff assisted by several other teachers act as the house wardens. Points are awarded to the students throughout the year. The house gaining the highest number of points is declared the winner and awarded with the 'Best House of the Year' trophy. Inter House competitions are organised in Sports, Dramatics, Debates, Music, Dance, Quiz and Arts.


