REPORT OF ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE MONTH OF MAY

Square Making Activity-

Square making with ice cream sticks is a magnificent shape recognition activity. This activity aims to develop the movements needed for muscular control of the fingers. Through this activity, students of Pre-Nursery practiced shape-building skills.



Tracing Line with Beads-

Through this activity, children learned about the lines by pasting different color beads. This activity offered an opportunity to learn through playing and develop creativity. It also helped in improving their eye-hand coordination.



Puppet Show(Art of Greeting)-

Greeting presents an opportunity for kids not only to show respect to others but also create a positive first impression of themselves. Pre-Nursery kids learned about the art of greeting with the help of puppets. The children were made aware of how to greet through this fruitful activity and all the children participated with great zeal and enthusiasm.



Role Play Activity-

Roleplay activity on the theme 'My Family' was conducted for the students of classes Pre- Nursery & Nursery on 11th May. Students came dressed up as various family members and portrayed the character of their respective family members by enacting like them and reciting a few lines. The teachers also explained to them how each family member is equally important. This activity also revived the importance of love and affection among the family members.



Lift Me Up! Activity -

Lift Me Up! activity was conducted for Nursery students to introduce the concept of heavy weight / light weight. They lifted chairs, tables, and a bundle of books to classify objects as heavy or light. Now they can differentiate objects based on their weight.



Vibgyor Activity-

Nursery children took active part in Vibgyor Activity. They learned about number 7 by pasting different colour circles on it. This activity offers an opportunity to learn numbers and colours in a creative way.



Folding Activity -

Folding Napkin is an interesting Montessori exercise for tiny tots in building independence, confidence, and fine motor skills. Nursery students folded napkins as per the instructions given by their teachers and this activity helped them in developing a better sense of muscular control. It is also a great way to prepare children for paper crafting or origami.



Vegetable Sandwich Making Activity-

This activity is a combination of fun and learning. Prep students brought brown bread, tomato slices, cucumber slices & cheese slice from their home and as the teacher demonstrated, children watched closely and assembled the same in the class. The teachers emphasized healthy eating habits and children were encouraged to make their sandwiches. They later relished the delicious self-made treats. This activity helped the young chefs in learning how to be self-reliant.
