## **GLIMPSES OF THE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER**

<u>Counting Activity</u> A counting activity was done for Pre-Nursery students in the class. In this activity, students counted the different objects and then picked the same number. They learned object counting and number recognition with the help of this activity.

<u>Scooping Activity-</u> Scooping activities are a great way to develop fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination in children. Keeping this in mind this activity was conducted in Nursery class. Children transferred small objects from one bowl to another and enjoyed this fun activity.



<u>Thick and thin activity with clay</u> - Nursery Children enjoyed making colorful bangles with the help of clay in this activity and also learned the difference between thick and thin. It helped in sensory development, hand-eye coordination, and motor skills as well.
