Thumb Printing Activity - A vibrant Thumb Printing activity was organized for UKG students. The young learners enthusiastically dipped their thumbs in colourful paints, unleashing their creativity and imagination to design beautiful and unique flower patterns. This engaging sensory activity not only brought joy and excitement but also played a vital role in strengthening the children's hand and finger muscles, contributing to their fine motor skill development.



Origami Activity- An Origami activity was conducted for UKG students to enhance their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination. The teachers guided the students through a step-by-step demonstration of creating an origami boat, and the students successfully crafted their own. It was a delightful activity that beautifully combined creativity, learning, and fun.



Addition Activity- A creative and educational activity combining mathematics and art was conducted for UKG students. The activity aimed to teach the concept of addition through a hands-on and visually engaging method using earbud printing.

Each student received four ladybug cutouts, divided into two parts with a line in the middle, along with four sets of addition problems. They used earbuds dipped in black paint to print dots corresponding to the numbers in the addition problems. For instance, for $3+2$, they printed 3 dots on one side of the ladybug and 2 dots on the other. After completing the printing, students counted the total dots to find the sum.

The students thoroughly enjoyed this interactive approach, which not only enhanced their understanding of addition but also stimulated their creativity and fine motor skills.



Quiz on Winter Season- UKG students participated in a fun quiz on winter season, learning about its characteristics, food, clothing, and festivals. The activity boosted their knowledge, confidence, and quick thinking. Students participated enthusiastically, making it a perfect blend of learning and fun.



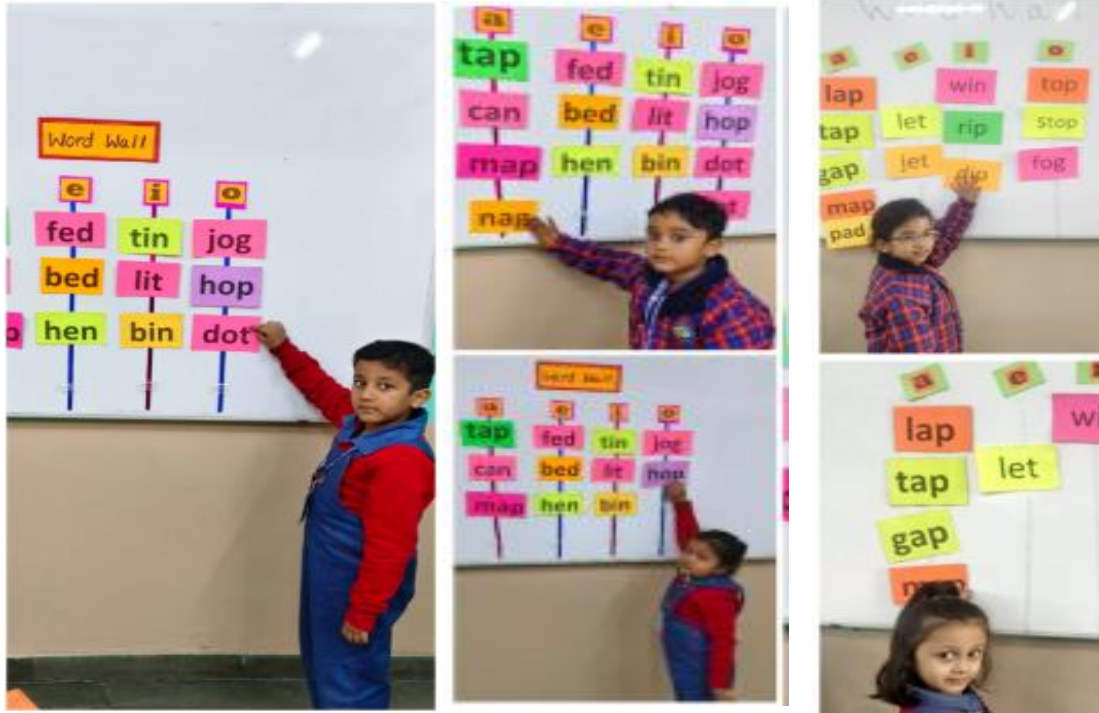

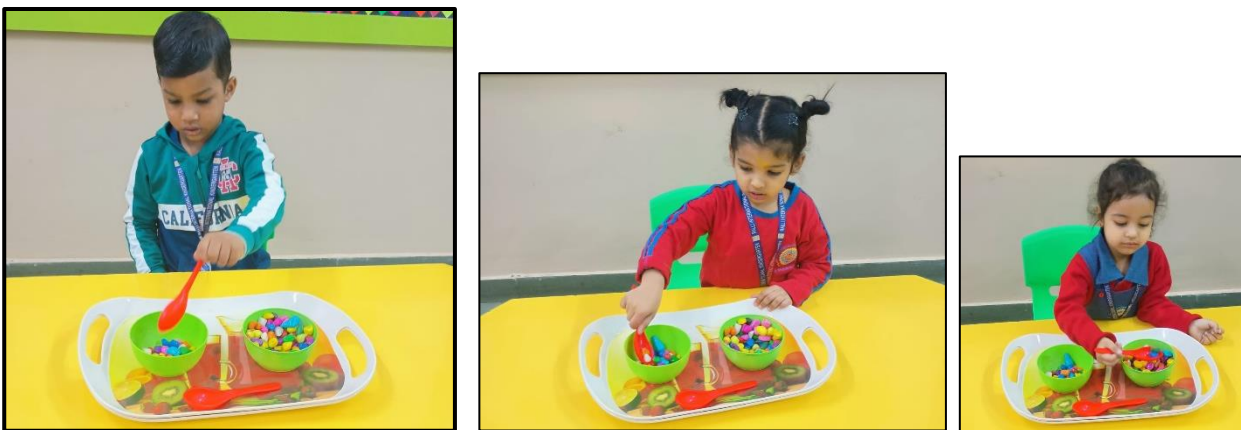
